Constitution & By Laws of the Stock Growers Association of Hamilton District Gallatin County Montana.

At a meeting of stock-growers held at Hamilton, Gallatin Co. Mont. February 28, 1881, Walcott Curtis was elected temporary chairman, & H. C. Cockhill secretary.

After considerable discussion of sheep & cattle grazing interests, participated in by Messrs. Chas. Ancney, J. H. Nixon, C. S. Lovett, R. B. Curtis, & others, it was moved that the chair appoint a Committee of three to report business for the consideration of the meeting. Messrs. Irvine, B. Hopkins, J. H. Nixon, & R. B. Curtis were appointed said Committee.

The committee reported the following, which was adopted by unanimous vote: Your committee would respectfully recommend the formation of an association of stock-growers between the Madison & Gallatin rivers, for the following purposes, to-wit: For the mutual protection of the actual settlers thereof; for the selection & pay of detectives in the employ of the association to secure mutual respect & equal rights between sheep & cattle raisers as now distributed in this district, & against the further introduction of sheep herds in the district named.
