Reference is made to my reports of November 11, 1942 and May 11, 1943 respectively:

I made an examination of this area on August 24, 1944, and wish to report as follows:

Plot No. 1	(Planted November 6, 1942)	18	B.B.
Plot No. 2	(Planted May 3, 1943)	0	B.B.
Plot No. 3	(Planted November 6, 1942)	6	B.B.
Plot No. 4	(Planted May 3, 1943)	0	B.B.
Plot No. 5	(Planted November 6, 1942)	0	B.B.
Plot No. 6	(Planted May 3, 1943)	0	B.B.
Test plots No. 1 & 2	(Planted November 6, 1942)	1	B.B. each

Bitter brush plants range in height from 1 to 4 inches and appear healthy. None of the other grass seed planted could be identified.

To me, this result proves that the fall sowing where ground was spaded and seed raked in is the preferred method.
