Dear Gus:

In talking with Stan Brown, our local Extension Service man, he suggested that it would be a very good plan, if convenient for you, to be in Susanville on March 26th to contact Mr. McClelland and select the cattle that you would want to graze Squaw Valley this coming season.

It would be more convenient for Mr. McClelland if he knew by March 26th just which cattle should be held for the experiment because at that time he is ~~round~~ ^{aged} up his cattle preparatory to sending them to the summer range, and if he knew just which ones you wanted, they could be segregated and held in a group until you are ready for them.

Mr. Brown also suggested that instead of grazing even ^{aged} stock as you did last year that it might be better if you ran three different grades of cattle. I do not know whether this arrangement would be satisfactory with you. However, this detail could be worked out if you could come to Susanville on March 26th.

Would appreciate your letting me know whether or not it would be possible for you to be present.
