Dear Stan:

Under separate cover I am sending you some graphs and tabulations showing the weight gains made by the three grades of heifers used in the Burgess Spring experiment. As you remember we selected 15 head of each of three grades making a total of 45 animals. Forty-three of this group were delivered to Burgess Spring, and in addition an extra one that had not been graded. I classified the latter in the lowest grade, minus 3 to 3. You will find therefore that the top grade, 3 to minus 3, had 13 animals. The middle grade, 3 to plus 3, had 14 head, and the lowest grade, minus 3 to 3, 16 head. The summaries (A and B on the bottom of tabulation sheet) and graph A show that there were no significant differences in weight gains in the three grades. This may mean that we do not have enough animals to make such a test, or that we did not have big enough differences in grades. Maybe you will have a different interpretation of the results.

If there is any more information I can give you please let me know. We will see you at the meeting.
