

The following is a true copy of the will of Thomas Folsom,
made at his request for transmission to his son, David E. Folsom,
by George N. Shepard,

I, Thomas Folsom of Epping in the County of Rockingham
and State of New Hampshire, being weak in body but of sound and perfect
mind and memory, blessed be God for the same, do make, publish and declare,
this my last will and testament, and herein and hereby dispose of all my
worldly estate in manner and form following, namely;

First. I give and bequeath to my son, George F. Folsom, ten dollars,
in addition to what I have already given him.

Second. I give and bequeath to my son, David E. Folsom, ten
dollars, in addition to what I have already given him.

Third. I give and bequeath to the heirs of my daughter, Mary
E. F. Hoag, one hundred dollars, to be equally divided among them.

Fourth. I give and bequeath to my five grandchildren, children
of my son, Thomas C. Folsom, five hundred dollars in equal shares,
namely, one hundred dollars to Mabel Abbie Folsom, one hundred
dollars to George Franklin Folsom, one hundred dollars to Edwin Sawyer Folsom,
one hundred dollars to Charles Albert Folsom and one hundred dollars to
Mary Evelyn Folsom.

Fifth. I give and bequeath to my grandson, David
Morrill Folsom, son of my said son, David E. Folsom, one
hundred dollars.

Sixth. I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved wife,
Soviah Folsom, during her natural life, the free use and
occupancy of my dwelling house and appurtenances, and all
my household furniture in said house, and I direct that my
executor, hereinafter named, shall provide all things necessary for
her comfortable support in sickness and in health in said house,
and from and after her decease, I give and bequeath and devise said
dwelling house and appurtenances and household furniture to my said
son, Thomas C. Folsom.

Seventh, I give, bequeath and devise unto my said son, Thomas C. Folsom, all the residue of my estate, whether real or personal, remaining after the payment of my just debts, legacies, funeral expenses and expenses of administration.

Eighth, I nominate my said son, Thomas C. Folsom, to be executor of this will, and hereby revoke all former wills.

In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand seal this thirteenth day of December, one thousand eight hundred and ninety.
